PE ATTIRE (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)

Students' PE uniform will change for the 2026-2027 school year!

Students will wear the **official BPA PE t-shirt** purchased through Palmetto Screen Print & Embroidery with **everyday bottoms** in Navy and Khaki.

Students MAY NOT Wear

- Athletic Shorts, Sweatpants, Leggings, Yoga pants

First Week Reminder

Students are NOT required to wear PE uniforms on Thursday, August 6 - the first day of school - since parents often take pictures on that day.

If your child has PE on Friday, August 7, he/she will wear the BPA PE t-shirt with **regular everyday bottoms**. Teachers will notify parents of each student's scheduled PE day.



SWEATSHIRTS & SHOES

Sweatshirts

Students may **ONLY** wear official BPA sweatshirts and hoodies purchased from Palmetto.

Socks

Solid:

- White
- Black
- Gray
- Navy

No multicolored or patterned socks.

Shoes

No athletic slides or bedroom slippers permitted.



DROP-OFF & DISMISSAL

Morning Drop-Off

7:15 AM – 8:05 AM

Students are considered tardy if they are not seated and ready by 8:10 AM.

Tardy Policy

- Tardies will NOT be recorded during the first week.
- Official tardy counts begin **Monday, August 17**.

Car Line Procedures

- Students must enter and exit only on the **passenger side**.
- Please adjust **car seats** as needed before drop-off and pick-up.
- Please do not place **backpacks** in trunks during pick-up.

Car Tags

Each family will receive 2 car tags at Meet-the-Teacher.

The car tags **MUST** be displayed until the student is in the car.

Anyone without a placard must report to the Main Office with ID.

Traffic Flow

Upon entering campus:

1. Enter Knights Court and follow the traffic circle around the school.
2. Proceed to the front car line.
3. Staff will assist with merging traffic.

Car Seat Policy

BPA staff may place students in vehicles, but **CANNOT** buckle seat belts or car seats.

If assistance is needed, please pull into a parking space.

DISMISSAL TIMES

- K5–5th Grade: 2:35 PM
- 6th–8th Grade: 2:55 PM

Younger siblings may be dismissed with older siblings.

Students who are picked up after designated dismissal times or after school hours may be required to pay a fee.

LUNCH

BPA does NOT provide breakfast or lunch.

Students must bring:

- Lunchbox with lunch
- Non-spill thermos. (No Capri Sun, soft drinks, or other drinks with twist tops and straws.)
- Napkins and Utensils - the school will not provide these items.

Microwaves and refrigerators are NOT available.

Please practice opening lunch items with younger students before school begins.

FIRST DAY PROCEDURES

K5

Parents may park and walk students to class on the first day.

1st Grade

Parents park and walk students to the front entry.

Grades 2–8

Students are dropped off in the carline and will be escorted to class by faculty and student ambassadors.
